Participation - I will try my best to take part in activities.

Respect - I will treat others with respect and value their contributions, no matter how small.

Responsibility - I will take responsibility for my own actions and behaviour.

Help! - I will seek help from an adult if I witness somebody breaking any of the above rules or behaving in a way that is likely to upset the safety or enjoyment of others.
